## **CANADIAN SPIRIT RESOURCES INC. PROVIDES FARRELL CREEK UPDATE**

Calgary, AB February 23, 2006 - Canadian Spirit Resources Inc. (“CSRI” or the “Company”) (SPI-TSX Venture) is pleased to announce that it has successfully fracture stimulated the Gething Formation at the b-92-H test hole. This test hole is currently being cleaned out to allow a down hole pump to be installed. Upon installation, this test hole will begin the dewatering phase similar to the Company’s test hole at c-83-H.

At the c-83-H test hole, the Company initiated the dewatering phase on January 16<sup>th</sup>. The current operating approach is to pump formation fluid out of the wellbore while keeping the gas production valve shut. CSRI has made significant progress in lowering the formation fluid level within the wellbore and is encouraged with the increasing pressure response from the formation. It is the Company’s intention that by mid-March, it will provide an indication of the productive capability associated with this test hole.

The Company is also pleased to advise that Sproule Associates Limited (“Sproule”) has begun preparing the annual evaluation which will be compliant with NI 51-101. Sproule will be reviewing all technical and operating data associated with the Gething Formation, Bluesky sandstone and Moosebar/Gates shales. Sproule anticipates completing this report by the end of March.

Canadian Spirit Resources Inc. is a natural resources company focusing on the identification and development opportunities in the unconventional gas sector of the energy industry. Since 2002, the mission of the Company has been to develop 1 Tcf of natural gas over a five year period from unconventional resource plays in western Canada. Within three years, the Company has identified several large resource plays, assembled a unique, high working interest land position in over 42,000 gross acres (of which 40,000 are located in British Columbia) and is currently evaluating the productive capability of its principal resource property.
